Disaster Signal Ribbons

To facilitate a city disaster plan and block captain system, all residences should post their condition after a disaster by placing a colored signal ribbon, flag or sheet on their house in a place that is easily visible from the street. Block Captains and CERT teams will be dispatched to the places with the most critical needs first.

Signal Colors:


Green-"GO" All is well! We are safe or we have evacuated our home

Yellow- "CAUTION" <u>Delayed</u>, Help is needed; It is NOT life threatening.

Red- "STOP" HELP! <u>Immediate</u> help or critical care is needed. Life threatening conditions.

Black- "DEAD" Deceased victims

If all of your family is safe but the house is not, then take your family and 72 hour kits to the Incident Command Post for further instructions.
