VAL JEFFS

I was born on September 7th, 1927, in Mohrland Utah. I was raised for seven years in Spring Canyon; they are both ghost towns now. I spent the rest of his life, except for the military time, in and around Salt Lake City UT. I graduated at 16, I was too young to join the Army or Navy. I then enlisted in the Merchant Marines. I also sailed on the SS Rainbow. It was an ammunition ship. They delivered to islands all over the South Pacific. Hundreds of tons. I was in the Philippines when Japan surrendered. I stayed in service until 1947 and was honorably discharged.

I married Dorothy Nelson in 1948, and we had three sons Sid, Scott, and Randy Jeffs which gave me three daughters-in-laws 6 grandchildren 7 great grandchildren and 2 great great grandchildren.

When the war in Korea started, I enlisted in the Air Force. I served four years active duty, then four years reserve. I then served on an air training base, Oklahoma. Also,

one year air sea rescue squadron on a B47 SAC base in French Morocco. And wing Headquarter on survival training base in Nevada. He was honorably discharged, rank S/Sgt.

My civilian careers were 15 years pharmaceutical sales and 15 years advertising sales. I then retired but after his wife Dorothy passed away in 1999, he went back to work in 2001 as a school crossing guard. He worked as a crossing guard for 10 years before retiring for a second time at the age of 85.

I am 97 years old I live in Heber with my grandson and his wife and three great grandchildren.



It will be located in the front lobby of the Senior Center to work on. We will assemble and display the puzzle in the County Fair the end of July.


