



## CONSTITUTIONAL AND STATUTORY QUALIFICATIONS

Before the filing officer accepts any declaration of candidacy, the filing officer shall read to the candidate the constitutional and statutory requirements for candidacy, and the candidate shall state whether he/she fulfills the requirements. If the candidate indicates that they do not qualify, the filing officer may not accept their declaration of candidacy (Utah Code Section 20A-9-203).

- Citizen of the United States.
- Have required state license (**if applicable**)
- o **County Attorney:** Attorney licensed to practice law in the state who is an active member in good standing of the Utah State Bar (17-68-202).
- o **County Assessor:** A state-licensed or state-certified appraiser (17-67-201).
- o **County Sheriff:** Met the standards and training requirements established for law enforcement officers under Title 53, Chapter 6, Part 2, Peace Officer Training and Certification Act, met the waiver requirements in Section 53-6-206, and is qualified to be certified as a law enforcement officer, as defined in Section 53-13-103 (17-72-201).
- Registered voter in Wasatch County.
- Be and remain a resident of Wasatch County for at least one year as of November 3, 2026.

## QUALIFICATIONS FOR CANDIDATE FILING DECLARATION

*Bev* I agree to file all campaign financial disclosure reports, and I understand that **failure to do so may result in my disqualification as a candidate** for this office, possible fines and/or criminal penalties, including removal of my name from the ballot.

*Bev* I provided a valid email, or physical address if no email is available, and I understand this will be used for official communications and updates from election officials.

*Bev* I understand that I will receive all financial disclosure notices by **email**.

*Bev* I have received a copy of Section 20A-7-801 regarding the **Statewide Electronic Voter Information Website Program** and its applicable deadline.

*Bev* I received a copy of the **Pledge of Fair Campaign Practices**, and I understand that signing this pledge is voluntary.

*Bev* I received a copy of the **current campaign financial disclosure laws**.

*Bev* I have paid the applicable **filing fee** of \$ \_\_\_\_\_.

*Bev* I understand that I can withdraw my candidacy at any time by filing a written affidavit with the Clerk/Auditor's office. I understand that I must withdraw at least 65 days before Election Day to have my name removed from the ballot.

*Bev* **County Attorney:** I submitted the following: a letter from the Utah Supreme Court, affirming that I am in good standing, proof of my application with the Utah State Bar, with an affidavit describing the status of my application or an affidavit describing how I intend to comply with the requirements for office of county attorney described in Subsection (3)(b)(i), and my license number with the Utah State Bar or any other state bar associations, if applicable.

*Bev* **County Sheriff:** I submitted a certificate issued by the Peace Officer Standards and Training Division created under Section 53-6-103.

*Bev* If filing via a designated agent, I will be out of the state of Utah during the entire candidate filing period.

\* A qualified voter (1) is a citizen of the United States; (2) is a resident of Utah; (3) will, on the date of that election: be at least 18 years old and have been a resident of Utah for 30 days immediately before that election; (4) and has registered to vote.

\*\*A person convicted of a felony loses the right to hold office until (1) all felony convictions have been expunged, OR (2) ten years have passed since the most recent felony conviction AND the person has paid all court-ordered restitution and fines AND the person has completed probation, been granted parole, or completed the term of incarceration associated with the felony.



# 2026 DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY

## PLEDGE OF FAIR CAMPAIGN PRACTICES

Information entered on this form is a **public record** under Utah Code § 63G-2. This form will be posted on [vote.utah.gov](http://vote.utah.gov). This is a **voluntary** pledge. Candidates are not required to sign this pledge to file a declaration of candidacy.

There are basic principles of decency, honesty, and fair play which every candidate for public office in the State of Utah has a moral obligation to observe and uphold, in order that, after vigorously contested but fairly conducted campaigns, our citizens may exercise their right to a free election, and that the will of the people may be fully and clearly expressed on the issues.

### **THEREFORE:**

**I SHALL** conduct my campaign openly and publicly, discussing the issues as I see them, presenting my record and policies with sincerity and frankness, and criticizing, without fear or favor, the record and policies of my opponents that I believe merit criticism.

**I SHALL NOT** use, nor shall I permit the use of, scurrilous attacks on any candidate or the candidate's immediate family. I shall not participate in, nor shall I permit the use of, defamation, libel, or slander against any candidate or the candidate's immediate family. I shall not participate in, nor shall I permit the use of, any other criticism of any candidate or the candidate's immediate family that I do not believe to be truthful, provable, and relevant to my campaign.

**I SHALL NOT** use, nor shall I permit the use of, any practice that tends to corrupt or undermine our American system of free elections, or that hinders or prevents the free expression of the will of the voters, including practices intended to hinder or prevent any eligible person from registering to vote or voting.

**I SHALL NOT** coerce election help or campaign contributions for myself or for any other candidate from my employees or volunteers.


**I SHALL** immediately and publicly repudiate support deriving from any individual or group which resorts, on behalf of my candidacy or in opposition to that of an opponent, to methods in violation of the letter or spirit of this pledge. I shall accept responsibility to take firm action against any subordinate who violates any provision of this pledge or the laws governing elections.

**I SHALL** defend and uphold the right of every qualified American voter to full and equal participation in the electoral process.
